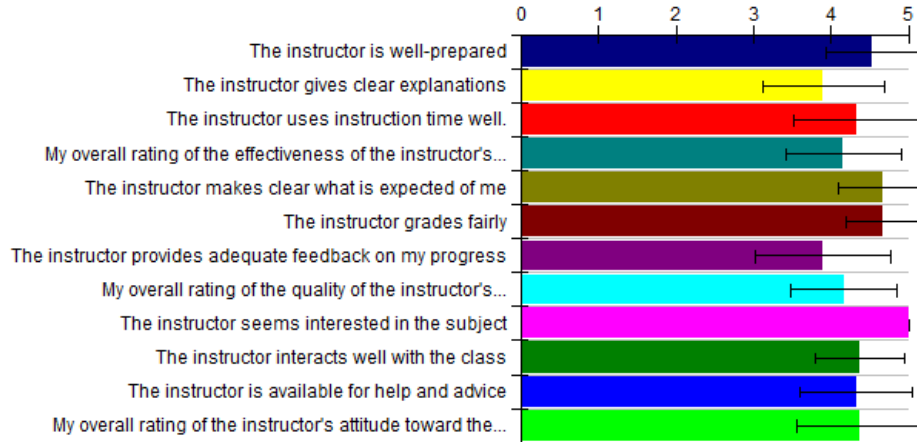

Question:	What is your overall opinion of this instructor as a teacher? Explain.

1	Overall, Professor Lorent has been my worst math professor thus far. He doesn't explain things well, and his handwriting is difficult to read. He spends a lot of time on simple material and not enough on harder stuff.
2	I think Prof. Lorent is very well prepared and teaches Calculus II very well. I believe he prepares the class more than enough for exams and offers many extra activities that can be used if a student is struggling. There is really no reason to receive a bad grade.
3	Professor Lorent is a highly skilled and helpful professor, although, at times he can be a little difficult to understand because he understands the material much better and it can be hard for him to teach it to the class from the simple basics.
4	He volunteers a lot of his time outside office hours to providing extra help for students. I think he does an admirable job teaching in class, and his extra review sessions are a huge help for me personally.
5	Good teacher, he seems to be really invested in the student's success. Holds review sessions every Friday and every weekend before exams.
6	Its clear that he knows the content, but the handwriting is often hard to read and the board is often behind him when he is speaking and so we can't see what he has written until he moves.
7	Good teacher in the sense that he is interested and knows the subject well but has trouble with going over on time for class causing problems in other classes.
8	He does an overall good job of covering all the material before an exam. For myself, personally, I felt as if sometimes he would almost move too quickly on some topics, while spending too much time on easier topics. He did pretty well at trying to get across the actual concepts, rather than just giving out equations and making the class assume things are the way they are.
9	Professor Lorent seems to really be interested in Calculus 2 and that makes calculus more tolerable than what it would have been otherwise.
10	He presents all of the course information in class in a neat manner. He also explains it well and goes through it quickly while giving students plenty of time to write notes. He offers help outside of class every week if people need it and has flexible meeting time.
11	Professor Lorent has his heart in the right place and you can tell that he enjoys math but he just makes multiple mistakes in class and I find myself lost sometimes because I do not really follow along too well for some reason.
12	This instructor is passionate about the subject and is willing to spend extra time outside of class with students to make sure they understand the material.
13	Fantastic teacher
14	I believe that Prof. Lorent is a fantastic instructor. He can sometimes go a little fast over certain topics but he will back track and explain it again if he asked to, provided he has enough time. Even if doesn't have the time to in class, he is always willing to at his office hours and at the Friday sessions he hosts.
15	Professor Lorent was a fair and effective teacher. He explained concepts thoroughly and offered review sessions with the sole condition that a base number of students must show interest.
16	Great teacher, maybe wasn't as empathetic to those students who needed extra instruction to grasp content
17	I thought they seemed clearly knowledgeable on the subject and overall they did fairly well at teaching the material. There were times when they didn't seem to go as in depth on a subject as they should have.

2	Overall, Professor Lorent is a very good teacher.
3	Distinguish between "r", "h", "k", "x", "v" and "u" when writing on the board.
4	Finish on time. Actually hold the review sessions.
5	When writing something on the board, he tends to block what he is writing with his body. I would recommend stepping to the side and waiting 5 seconds after writing something down on the board before quickly preceding to the next topic.
6	The homework seems a bit too lengthy. I don't know a good way to fix it, but it is hard to get done every week in time.
7	Professor Lorent should slow down just a bit, just enough to check and make sure he is not screwing up on the little stuff like a minus sign or a number to a power of 2 instead of 3 or something like that.
8	My only complaint is that the class was moved to Edwards, and the class would often let out a couple minutes late. This gave barely any time to get to my next class across campus.
9	None that come presently to mind.
10	My major gripe with the class which was beyond any control was that Professor Lorent's office hours directly overlapped another class, making availability much less possible.
