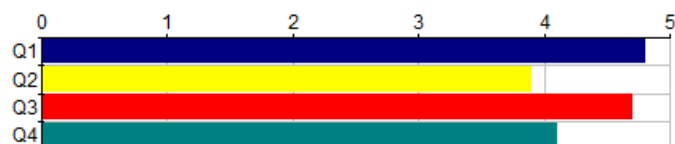
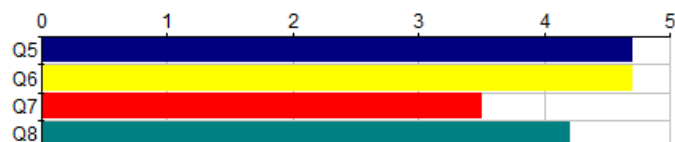

- This instructor, Prof. Lorent, worked very well with hybrid learning. He made sure to ensure that we were actually taking notes by having us submit weekly notes online through canvas. He also showed prime examples of problems we would need to know and made sure we understood what we were doing rather than just memorizing the path we needed to take to get the solution.

2	Professor Lorent, definitely knows his math but struggles to explain it for students to grasp the concept. Wish he had clearer explanations. Also, went quickly on stuff some students didn't know.
3	Professor Lorent clearly understands the topics very well and loves the subject, but at times felt almost too smart to teach the class. I took calculus in high school and did very well, but sometimes his explanations for topics I already understood felt overly complicated and went over my head. Once he got to the point I was able to figure out what he meant, but the explanations were confusing at times.
4	Professor Lorent is fully indulged in teaching Calculus. I love being able to have a class where the professor is passionate about the subject.
5	Professor Lorent was an exceptional teacher and I felt the class was very well put together especially under the circumstances.
6	Profesor Lorent is an inspiring person. He knows the material well and it's clear that he's passionate about teaching it.
7	Prof. Lorent did a very good job. He was obviously very passionate about the topic and clearly knew what he was doing.
